2. How would you describe the performance of the upper-tier municipality in terms of making decisions and delivering services in your community?

I don't think the Region of Peel works for Mississauga. It's not fair to me as a taxpayer because I have to subsidize Brampton and Caledon and it holds my city back from doing the things I want like building housing and transit.

3. How would you describe the performance of the lower-tier municipality in terms of making decisions and delivering services in your community?

I think the City of Mississauga works well. If I have a problem I can call 311 or my Councillor. I think most people in Mississauga are very happy with their services.

4. In general, how might upper- or lower-tier municipalities be improved?

I don't think we need another level of government on top of the City of Mississauga. From what I've seen it's confusing and wasteful. I think Mississauga would be better off as an independent city. I also think eliminating the Region of Peel and making Mississauga independent would mean better customer service, less cost, and I would only have one government to call if I have a problem.

Governance

I don't know why we need another council to make decisions. It's not fair that Mississauga has to debate with two other cities to get things done. We're a big city and we can make our own decisions.

Decision-Making

Service Delivery
