Purpose


To gauge resident awareness of the Province of Ontario's review of regional governance and the level of support for the City of Mississauga to leave the Region of Peel and become a separate city.

- Margin of error +/- 3.1%


Survey Results

Awareness of Regional Governance Review



^{*}Awareness was strongest for those between the ages of 55-64 (61%) and weakest for those between the ages of 18-24 (35%).

Support for Separation from the Region of Peel (All Respondents)



^{*}Support for separation from the Region of Peel was strongest among those between the ages of 45-54 (57%) with support weakest for those between the ages of 25-34 (32%).
