NOTICE

All organizations that hold Lottery Licences issued by the City of Mississauga are required to provide completed Criminal Record Search (CRS) report forms.

- Forms are required for: President, Vice President, Treasurer, (or equivalent) <u>and</u> any other person who has signing authority on the lottery bank account.
- Each organization must ensure that we have a current board/executive list any new names (as listed above) will need to provide a CRS.
- Applicants are required to attend their local police agencies. Reimbursement may be made from the lottery bank account (note that reimbursement is NOT permitted for credit card payments).
- For lottery purposes, we require a Police Information Check form. **If** a Vulnerable Sector form must be provided by an individual for other purposes (ie sports groups, volunteering with children) we will take a copy of the <u>original</u> processed form.
- If a CRS has already been processed, we will accept that <u>original</u> form as long as it has been processed within the last 6 months.
- You or someone you trust must bring the original CRS into our office. If the original is required back, our office staff will make a "true copy", and give the original back to you or to the trusted individual.
- We will not accept copies.
- If they are not needed back, original reports can be mailed or delivered to our office.
- Please make sure to write your organization's name at the top of the report before you provide it to our office.
- We do not accept Criminal Record Searches processed through a third party.
