
DRAFT STRATEGIES AND ACTIONS: TRACKING

Deliverables for this project include two stand-alone documents - the Natural Heritage & Urban Forest Strategy (NH&UFS) and the Urban Forest Management Plan (UFMP). The Strategies are from the NH&UFS, while the supporting Actions are from the UFMP.

Targets are one way to track the status of the Natural Heritage System and Urban Forest in Mississauga, but they only tell part of the story. Comprehensive monitoring includes looking at how the City is progressing in terms of overall planning and management, and the degree to which the community and other stakeholders are being engaged.
