General Programs		
Drop In Fun Skate	Program Info: For ages 3 years and older. Have a great time on the ice skating with your family and friends. All participants must wear ice skates while on the ice. Children cannot be carried on the ice. Approved skating aids are permitted.  Tickets and wristbands: Tickets sales begin 30 minutes prior to the program start time. All participants must pay for admittance and wear a wristband, as proof of payment, while on the ice.  Please note: A CSA approved hockey helmet is recommended for all skaters.	
Drop In Figure Skating	Program Info: Practice your spins, jumps and figure skating programs. You must be a competent forward and backward skater and be able to turn comfortably from forward and backward with speed to attend this program.  Ages: 6yrs and older.  Tickets and wristbands: Tickets sales begin 30 minutes prior to the program start time. All participants must pay for admittance and wear a wristband, as proof of payment, while on the ice.  Please note: On ice coaches must also pay drop in price. Program is unsupervised.	
Adult Programs		
Drop In Adult and Older Adult Skate	Program Info: For ages 18 years and older. Have a great time on the ice skating with other adults. All participants must wear ice skates while on the ice. Approved skating aids are permitted.  Tickets and wristbands: Tickets sales begin 30 minutes prior to the program start time. All participants must pay for admittance and wear a wristband, as proof of payment, while on the ice.  Please note: A CSA approved hockey helmet is recommended for all skaters. Program is unsupervised.	
Drop In 55+ Skate	Program Info: For ages 55 years and older. Have a great time on the ice skating with other adults. All participants must wear ice skates while on the ice. Approved skating aids are permitted.  Tickets and wristbands: Tickets sales begin 30 minutes prior to the program start time. Drop In Adult Cardio Skate	Ages: 18yrs and older Prerequisite: You must be a competent forward and backward skater and be able to turn from forward and backward with speed. Tickets and wristbands: Tickets sales begin 30 minutes prior to the program start time. All participants must pay for admittance and wear a wristband, as proof of payment, while on the ice. Program Info: A supervised fast-paced skate session using the entire ice surface incorporating skating skill drills with music. A definite workout!	
Drop In Figure Skating Patch	Program Info: Figure Skaters – practice your figure eights in a quiet 50 minutes on the ice.  Ages: 18yrs and older  Tickets and wristbands: Tickets sales begin 30 minutes prior to the program start time. All participants must pay for admittance

Tickets and Wristbands: Tickets will be sold 30 minutes prior to program start time. All participants must pay for admittance and wear a wristband issued as proof of payment. Goalies (wearing full equipment) that would like to participate in the shinny program are permitted to play for free.  Equipment Required: Full hockey equipment is mandatory for all program participants including CSA approved hockey helmet with facial protection (cage). Only approved hockey skates are permitted on the ice. No equipment rentals available.  Please note: This is a non-contact program. Participants must allow one another equitable playing time and adhere to the posted code of conduct. Goalies are not provided.

Hockey Stick & Puck Programs		
Drop In Hockey Stick & Puck (3-13 yrs with Adult)	Program Info: This supervised program offers adults and children the opportunity to work on basic stick/puck handling and skating skills together. Each adult may bring a maximum of 3 children. All children must be accompanied by an adult on the ice or at rink side to monitor their child.  Capacity for this program - 30 participants (includes children and adults). Program is intended to maximize child participation.  One adult per child. One adult may supervise up to 3 children max.  Tickets: Tickets will be sold 30 minutes prior to the start time of the program.	
	Equipment Required: Skates and CSA approved helmets are mandatory equipment for all program participants. All participants 17 and under must have a cage on their helmet. A cage or visor is highly recommended for participants 18 years +.  Please note: Hockey players wishing to wear their full hockey equipment or goalie equipment are welcome to participate in the program to practice their skating skills and stick handling only. There is no scrimmage, or shinny play. Maximum 2 goalies in full equipment allowed in net during the program.	
Drop In Hockey Stick & Puck (14-17 yrs)	Program Info: This supervised program offers participants the opportunity to work on basic stick/puck handling and skating skills. Capacity for this program - 30 participants  Equipment Required: Hockey skates and CSA approved helmets are mandatory equipment for all program participants.  Please note: Hockey players wishing to wear their full hockey equipment or goalie equipment are welcome to participate in the program to practice their skating skills and stick handling only.
