### Bronze Cross & Standard First Aid/CPR C

\*Prerequisites: Bronze Medallion & Emergency First Aid/CPR B



#### Distinction (optional)

\*Prerequisites: Bronze Cross



#### Lifesaving Society Assistant Instructor (recommended)

\*Prerequisites: Bronze Cross or higher and 14 years of age

#### National Lifeguard Service (Pool)

\*Prerequisites: Bronze Cross and Standard First Aid/CPR C and 16 years of age



#### Lifesaving Society Swim/Lifesaving Instructors with PHCD

\*Prerequisites: Bronze Cross and Standard First Aid/CPR C and 16 years of age
