- Training and business skills development to help youth develop a business plan and prepare to run their own business;
- Where eligible, a micro-grant of up to \$5,000 to help kick-start a new business, expand an existing business or buy a business;
- Mentorship and guidance from local business professionals and consultants to help youth get their business up and running;
- Experience running a business that will better position youth to obtain more traditional financing and create additional jobs.

## **PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

To be eligible to participate in the Starter Company program, you must meet the following requirements:

- Be 18 years to 29 years old;
- Not be a full-time student;
- Be a resident of Ontario;
- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident;
- Proposing a new business, expansion of an existing business or buying a business;
- Prepared to commit to a minimum of 35 hours a week to running the business;
- Prepared to attend monthly meetings for at least six months after the start or assumed ownership of a business;
- Have not received a Starter Company Program grant in the past;
- Not currently enrolled in the Self-Employment Benefit (SEB) Program;
- Able to match micro-grant amount by 25 per cent.
