Woodlands Library Facts

- The official opening of the new Woodlands Library was celebrated on Saturday, June 21 at 11 a.m.
- The new library opened June 3, 2014.
- It is located at 3255 Erindale
 Station Rd. The entrance to the
 parking lot is shared with The
 Woodlands School.
- The cost of the new library is \$4 million.
- The new Woodlands library features: an accessible building, welcoming facility, quiet study rooms, bookable community room with a/v projector, green features including energy efficient equipment, self-check-out, fireplace, large floor-to-ceiling windows and a children's computer.
- Collection size of over 41,000 items, circulation of almost 200,000 items annually, and over

200 programs annually.

- In the future it will also include a small outdoor reading space sponsored by The Friends of the Mississauga Library System.
- The original Woodlands Library opened April 7, 1975.
- It was 5,500 sq ft. and located at 1030 McBride Avenue.
- The original library closed May 11, 2014.
- The 2004 Library Master Plan called for the redevelopment of Woodlands Library. Due to its age, mechanical updates were needed to make the facility more accessible and functional.
- One of the City of Mississauga's strategic goals is to build and maintain infrastructure for its citizens, and for generations to come.
