

## City of Mississauga Harbour Operations – Credit Village Marina Winter Newsletter

Please note the following for the 2018 season:

**\*NEW \***

- Any Motorized Personal Watercraft (PWC) must provide proof of insurance meeting all requirements set out by the City of Mississauga.
- All Seasonal and Charter Vessels **must** use rubber mooring snubbers. Mooring Snubbers minimize mooring line breakage along with compensating for sudden jolting and excess stretching of lines beyond parting strength and provide protection against stress caused by wind, waves, and surge.



### 2018 Slip Renewal

- Slip renewal dates are **January 15<sup>th</sup>** for the \$500.00 deposit and **March 15<sup>th</sup>** for the balance payment.
- In order to save paper an online copy has been submitted and emailed directly
- Marina fees have increased slightly for the 2018 boating season to \$85.34 a foot; these fees were Council approved.
- Charter Marina fees have also increased slightly for the 2018 boating season to \$68.80 a foot; these fees were Council approved.
- All Seasonal and Charter boaters are expected to submit a copy of valid insurance and Vessel Registration issued by Transport Canada for the 2018 summer season by January 15<sup>th</sup> 2018. This will be part of the application process moving forward regardless of what was submitted the year before. It is the boater's responsibility to obtain and submit these documents accordingly.
- Credit Village Marina is closed for the season; if dropping in please do so at Lakefront Promenade Public Marina, 135 Lakefront Promenade Rd., L5E 3G9. Please call the marina office (905)615-4870 to book an appointment
- We will be on a cashless operation over the winter months. If you are planning on paying with cash, please bring the exact amount as we will not be able to give change. Please call ahead over the Christmas/New Year break, as the marina office will be shut down from December 23<sup>rd</sup> 2017 – January 7<sup>th</sup> 2018.
- Review your contract for accuracy.
- Refer to your contract for any requirements needed for your 2018 renewal.
- Once all payments are received and vacant slips are known, we will begin going through our slip relocation requests. We will assign slips according to boat size, availability, and best fit for the marina.

### Insurance Requirements – Charter & Seasonal

a Certificate of Insurance evidencing: General Liability insurance including third party bodily injury and property damage coverage, in the amount of \$2,000,000 per occurrence; The Corporation of the City of Mississauga as an additional insured (see attached PDF for details); and a 15 days prior written notice of cancellation

### Transient Boating

- Please understand that Credit Village Marina is first and foremost a transient marina. Expect to share a well with visiting boats and prepare accordingly.
- Expect some event weekends to have little to no vacancy.
