


CONCEPT OPTIONS

CONCEPT A Active and Passive Recreation Park

- A park that is everything to everyone.
- Balance between active and passive spaces / uses.
- Upgrades and refurbishment of existing park assets.
- Cultural gathering facilities will be expanded and upgraded.


CONCEPT B Natural Heritage and Cultural Destination Park


- A park that is a community and cultural destination.
- Focus on health and sustainability of natural environment.
- Drop-in sports facilities designed to complement gathering spaces.
- Infrastructure phased out of floodplain.
- Provide 'green infrastructure' functions for community and region.






