

Fact Sheet: Stormwater Credits

- The credit program offers a reduction of up to 50% of the stormwater charge on properties that have stormwater management on-site
- Multi-residential and Non-residential properties are eligible for the credit program:
 - These properties make up 68% of the stormwater billing units in Mississauga.
 - The most significant reduction of stormwater runoff can come from these properties.
- Credits are awarded in four weighted categories:

Category	Credit Amount (to a total amount of no more than 50%)
Peak Flow Reduction	Up to 40 %
Water Quality Treatment	Up to 10 %
Runoff Volume Reduction	Up to 15 %
Pollution Prevention	Up to 5 %

- The maximum credit of 50% was set to reflect the benefit that on-site stormwater works can have on the City system; 50% of the City's stormwater program cannot be impacted by improved stormwater management on private property
- The relative weighting of each of the 4 credit categories reflects the aspects of the City's program that are impacted by improved stormwater management on private property
- Participation in the credit program is by application only; applications will be reviewed by City staff
- Credits are subject to terms and conditions including:
 - Credits must be renewed by application after 5 years
 - Credited works must be maintained and may be inspected at any time
 - Changes to property that affect credited works must be reported for re-evaluation
- Applications will open in early Fall 2015
- A workshop will be held for interested applicants
- Applications received in the first year will be retroactively credited to first day of charge
