The applicant is requesting an amendment to the Mississauga Official Plan policies for the Meadowvale Village Neighbourhood Character Area from "Business Employment", "Residential Low Density II" and "Greenbelt" to "Business Employment – Special Site", "Residential Low Density II – Special Site", "Private Open Space", and "Greenbelt";

In addition, a change in zoning is being requested for the subject lands from "D" (Development) and "G1" (Greenbelt - Natural Hazards) to "E2 - Exception" (Employment), "R11" (Detached Dwellings - Garage Control Lots), "RM2 - Exception" (Semi-Detached Dwellings), "G1" (Greenbelt – Natural Hazards), "G2 - Exception" (Greenbelt – Natural Features) and "OS1" (Open Space);

Approval of a proposed Plan of Subdivision comprised of 37 detached dwellings, 8 semidetached dwelling units, a business employment block, open space, greenbelt lands and the extension of Longview Place is also required.

Bill 51 Applications

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, or make written submissions to the City of Mississauga before the by-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
