NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION

McLaughlin Road Environmental Assessment Study

The City of Mississauga has completed an Environmental Assessment (Class EA) including Preliminary Design for the section of McLaughlin Road from Bristol Road West to Britannia Road West. It was conducted in accordance with the planning and design process for 'Schedule C' projects as outlined in the Municipal Engineers Association "Municipal Class Environmental Assessment," (October 2000, as amended in 2011) approved under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.

The study was undertaken to investigate the need for additional north-south capacity and traffic management improvements along this section of McLaughlin Road, while taking into consideration the Scenic Route designation, adjacent land use, and City plans for a cycling route and streetscape improvement opportunities. It followed a comprehensive, sound and open planning process with three formal public meetings (January 29, 2013, March 5, 2014, and May 9, 2015) to discuss the multi-modal transportation needs of the corridor.

Following a context sensitive approach, McLaughlin Road is proposed to be four travel lanes including cycling facilities, improved sidewalk connectivity, buried hydro lines, tree planting and landscaping, and replacement of existing noise barriers. The preferred design also includes edge restoration along the Britannia Farm woodlot.

The Environmental Study Report (ESR) has been prepared to document the planning and decision-making process that was followed during this study. By this Notice, the ESR is being placed on the public record for a 30 day review period from and including January 18, 2016 to February 17, 2016 at the following locations and through the website below:
