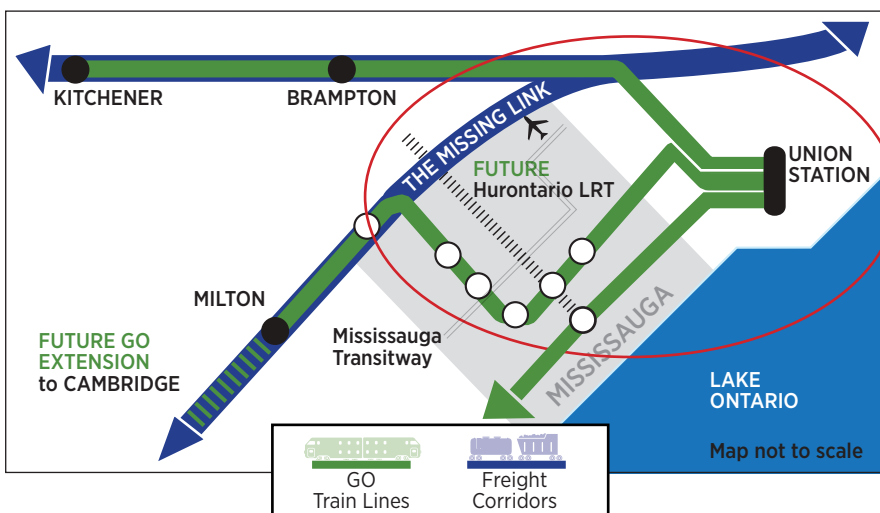

## PROBLEM



Freight rail traffic is preventing Mississauga from securing frequent, all-day, two-way GO Train service on the Milton and Kitchener GO Lines and building a regionally-connected rail service for almost 800,000 people.

## SOLUTION: MISSING LINK



The Missing Link is a package of rail improvements that would divert freight from existing GO Transit lines to a new freight rail corridor. This would allow for substantially expanded service on the Milton and Kitchener GO Transit lines, including two-way, all-day service. Additional benefits include:

- easier electrification of GO Transit lines,
- quicker movement of goods to market, and
- improved safety.
