Subject: Referral of Region of Peel Projects to the Facility Accessibility Design Subcommittee

Recommendation:

1. That the Region of Peel Accessibility Advisory Committee be given clear direction regarding the review of The Region's facilities projects in the City of Mississauga by The City of Mississauga Facility Accessibility Design Subcommittee.
2. That The Region of Peel Accessibility Advisory Committee direct copies of their Minutes of Meetings at which projects in The City of Mississauga are discussed to The City of Mississauga Facility Accessibility Design Subcommittee and to The City of Mississauga Planning and Building Department, Development and Design Division, for their respective records.
3. That, upon receipt of these Minutes, The City of Mississauga Facilities Accessibility Design Subcommittee reserves the right to request an additional review of The Region's facilities projects.

Background:

Staff from The Region of Peel, Construction Project Management Department, Real Property Asset Management Division have contacted The City of Mississauga Planning and Building Department, Development and Design Division in order to determine whether referral of The Region's facilities projects to The City of Mississauga Facility Accessibility Design Subcommittee is a condition of approval through The City of Mississauga's Site Plan Development Application process (with specific in reference to the proposed Region of Peel Paramedic Satellite Station # 9 to be constructed at 5181 Falbourne Street, File # SP 15/038 W5). Region staff were advised that this is not currently a requirement of Site Plan Approval.

Comment:

The Ontario Planning Act requires that municipalities and planning boards have regard to access for persons with disabilities to all facilities, services, and matters to which The Act applies.

The Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005, Ontario Regulation 191/11, Integrated Accessibility Standards Regulation (O. Reg. 413/12, under the AODA) requires that designated public sector organizations, including municipalities, consult with persons with

disabilities regarding trails, playgrounds, exterior paths of travel and on-street parking. In addition, if they have established an Accessibility Advisory Committee, public sector organizations must consult with The Committee.

In response to The Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act and The Ontario Planning Act, The City of Mississauga's Planning and Building Department circulates all applications for City facilities (new builds and major renovation projects) to The Mississauga Accessibility Advisory Committee.

In accordance with Recommendation ACC-003-2012 approved by General Committee on February 15, 2012 and subsequently adopted by Council on February 22, 2012, the Mississauga Accessibility Advisory Committee's Facility Accessibility Design Subcommittee (FADS) is to review municipal facility projects (new builds and major renovation projects). The recommendation is silent in relation to Regional facilities and the circulation of Region of Peel projects to The City's Accessibility Advisory Committee is not clearly addressed.



All of the Region of Peel's facilities projects are currently referred to the Region of Peel Accessibility Advisory Committee for review, addressing the requirements of The Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act.

Conclusion:

Clarity in procedures for the review of The Region of Peel's projects by The Region of Peel Accessibility Advisory Committee and The City of Mississauga Facility Accessibility Design Subcommittee will simplify the approvals process for these developments.

The review of The Region of Peel's facilities projects by both The Region of Peel Accessibility Advisory Committee and The City of Mississauga Facility Accessibility Design Subcommittee may represent a duplication of effort; however, no clear protocol exists in relation to this matter.
