Paul Mitcham, Commissioner of Community Services requested a revision to the priority list to move the parking lots in Ward 11 up to 35 and thanked staff for their work on preparing the report in such a short amount of time. Members of Council thanked the federal government members of parliament in Mississauga who informed them of the Canada 150 Community Infrastructure Program (CIP 150) and thanked staff for their hard work in prioritizing each project within the Wards. Councillor Saito requested priority 25 include an addition of adult fitness equipment at Middlebury Park.

WHEREAS the Peel District School Board Physical Planning and Building Committee at its June 2, 2015 meeting supported the Peel District School Board's financial investment to be included in the City's grant submission for the Clarkson Park Field Redevelopment – Artificial Turf capital project; AND WHEREAS the Peel District School Board have requested the addition of a scoreboard, track conversion to synthetic surface, and 2 additional track lanes;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City of Mississauga's submission to the Canada 150 Community Infrastructure Program be amended to include the revised scope and costs of \$ 2.9 million for the Clarkson Park capital project, and revised cost sharing to be 3-way, with approximately 1/3 shared by each of the Peel District School Board, City of Mississauga, and the Federal Government.
