Subject: Barbertown Bridge Rehabilitation Project Invitation to Public Information Centre

The Community Services Department has begun an Environmental Assessment (EA) for the rehabilitation of the Barbertown Bridge. The EA will establish an option that best addresses a series of criteria. The bridge built circa 1900 has a high cultural heritage component with very few remaining in North America. Adjacent to the Culham Trail it serves as a link along Barbertown Road connecting Mississauga Road to Eglinton Avenue West. Barbertown Road is identified as a proposed secondary road route within the Cycling Master Plan.

The Committee will be formally invited in the coming weeks. However, I would like to personally invite all members of the committee and staff to attend the Public Information Centre (PIC) for this project.

Saturday October 3, 2015. Portico Community Church 1814 Barbertown Road 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.


Attending will provide a very good understanding of the issues and challenges facing the future of the bridge. Your input is very important. The EA options being considered.

- Do nothing leave it open in its current pedestrian crossing. With regular maintenance to sustain it. The bridge will eventually reach its end of life and be closed in the future.
- 2. Full closure of the bridge to the public and leave it as a heritage artifact.
- 3. Built a new bridge elsewhere along the river removing the existing bridge
- 4. Full replacement or rehabilitation of the existing bridge and abutments.
- 5. Complete removal of the bridge and abutments.

There will be an opportunity as individuals to formally comment at the PIC. Following the PIC event ([will come to the Committee to discuss the project and hear your comments.




