PRESENTATIONS / DEPUTATIONS

Matt Naomi and Nadim Anwar, Parking Enforcement Officers spoke to Traffic Safety Council (TSC) spoke to TSC regarding the efforts of the Parking Enforcement School Enforcement Committee. Since its implementation in January 2013, the committee has increased their school zone patrols from 4 to 12 schools per day; created a data base to track infractions and statistics. Information relating to *Highway Traffic Act infractions* are now easily identified and shared with Peel Regional Police. Parking Enforcement Officers hand out information brochures to parents while they drop off or pick up their children, as well as Parking Enforcement Officers have been invited to attend school open houses to set up a booth to provide information to parents and students. The School Enforcement Committee will continue to work with school staff to identify problem locations and times and would like to see more communication sent out to parents, especially parents of Junior and Senior Kindergarten students.

Councillor Frank Dale requested that statistical information be provided to TSC for schools that have Kiss & Ride/Dismissal issues. Denise Gordon-Mohamud advised that the parking lot adjacent to McKinnon Public School, has safety issues. Mr. Naomi advised that he would investigate this matter. Matthew Moore inquired about statistics on parking ticket challenged in court. Barry Foley, Manager of Parking Enforcement advised that they only track the number of tickets issued.

Site Plan Review

Traffic Safety Council Criteria for reviewing Site Plan

OBJECTIVE:

The objective of the review of the site plan is to ensure that vehicular traffic can enter and exit the school site while protecting the student pedestrian movements around the site.

The recommendations and criteria have been developed over many years of observing parent behaviour on and around school sites in the City of Mississauga. Each site is reviewed in the context of the unique constraints of the site, however there are some common challenges to every site.

CRITERIA:

- Where possible, the bus loading zone and car loading zone should be separated and drop-off/ pick-up is to be curb side.
- Where possible, pedestrian walking routes to access to the property from the municipal sidewalk should not cross the path of vehicular travel.
- Where a pedestrian walking route on the school property is required to cross the vehicular driveway, the walkway should be delineated with 'zebra stripe' paint markings. Ideally the walkway should be raised in the form of a speed hump so as to reduce vehicular speed at the crossing.
- The driveways for vehicular travel should be one-way. This reduces on-site traffic congestion and ensure smooth flow of traffic on the site.
- Parking occurs on the street in front of schools and parents use this area as a supplementary drop-off area. This results in student pedestrians crossing the boulevard, sidewalk and front driveway of the school in an unorganized and thus dangerous manner. As a result, a fence is requested across the front of many sites to direct pedestrian traffic along sidewalks and to use identified walkways.
- Walkways crossing the front driveway should be discouraged.
- The design of the drive aisles related to the drop-off areas should minimize the number of parking spaces accessed off the aisle so as to minimize traffic interference with parking vehicles. Where parking is accessing the aisle, it should be on one side of the aisle only.

- Consideration is to be given to the number of busses that serve the site so that there is sufficient room to store the busses on the site at dismissal time.
- Drop-off areas should be indicated with paint marking on the driveway.
- Lanes should be painted with yellow paint.
- Arrows indicating direction of travel should be painted on driveways.
- A painted stop bar on the driveway and corresponding stop sign should be located at the end of the drop-off lane with the appropriate relationship to the school entrance or playground area access.
- One Way signs should be incorporated to direct drivers to maintain a one-way traffic flow.
- One Way signs should be incorporated at entrance and exit access to ensure that drivers are directed to use the driveways properly.
- Do Not Enter signs should be placed on—site to ensure that traffic flow is maintained in a one way direction where appropriate.
- Signage for visitor parking and staff parking should be used to reduce parking interference with traffic flow.
- Parking spaces are required to be designated for the parents of children attending Full Day Kindergarten (FDK).
- Signage for FDK parking spaces should incorporated.
- The location of FDK parking spaces should be reviewed to ensure that the spaces are located appropriate relative to the location of the FDK student checkin area and so as not create conflicts with the bus and car loading areas.







Hello Ms. Mahoney,

I live in the Winston Churchill/403 area. Of course you are aware of the terrible incident that occurred yesterday in our neighbourhood at 8:20am where a 4 year old child lost his life when struck by a car while walking to Artesian Drive Public School with his parent at the intersection of Artesian and South Hampton.

We have not been told about all of the specifics of how this happened but I feel that if certain things were done, the risk of another similar incident occurring could be greatly reduced. The intersection of South Hampton/Artesian and LongAcre/Artesian are extremely busy in the mornings. It is a relatively young neighbourhood with young families so everybody is out early either dropping kids off or hurrying off to work. On top of the regular rush from neighbourhood residents, we have individuals who choose to cut through our neighbourhood from Eglinton Avenue in an effort to get to Winston Churchill Blvd. faster. Both of the intersections mentioned above on Artesian are 4 way stops and I cannot tell you the number of times I see people either not stopping or rolling through the stop signs. I would like to see an increased police presence in the morning in our neighbourhood for these reasons.

Also, we currently have one crossing guard at LongAcre/Artesian and no crossing guard at South Hampton/Artesian. The one crossing guard is completely overwhelmed as the amount of foot traffic in the morning is immense. The poor lady does her best but she only crosses in an L shape pattern although it is a 4 way stop (the entire square should be covered but it is impossible for one person). I would like to see two crossing guards at LongAcre/Artesian and another two at SouthHampton/Artesian. Can you or the City request that or discuss that with the school board so that we can make it safer for the children?

Please let me know what is being done to assess the situation and what recommendations are or will be put forth to prevent a similar tragedy from occurring. My son goes to that school and this could be any one of our kids.

Happy New Year! I hope that you keep recovering successful after your surgery.

I'd like to share my concern about a situation that is getting worse every morning in the surroundings of the Saint Bernard of Clairvaux School (Scada Dr).

An accident is meant to happen at any time due to the attitude of careless parents who refuse to use the kiss and ride of the school. These parents irresponsibly drop their kids in the street causing chaos, unnecessary delays, congestion and more importantly unsafe situations that sooner than later will hurt someone.

In my opinion, the school did and keep doing everything in their power to convey a message about the risks of this practice. The principal even dedicated part of his speech during the Christmas concert to talk about this. I don't think it is about the school anymore. I think it is about law enforcement.

The kiss and ride works extremely well and I don't understand why these parents refuse to use it.

When you add the icy conditions of the street, and low visibility cause by cars parked at both sides, what we have is a recipe for disaster.

We cannot wait until somebody gets hurt to do something about this. The School personnel and Mr Teti, the principal are doing an amazing job, but these careless parents keep ignoring the school authorities. Even basic traffic signs like "do not turn left", do not park, No U turn, etc are ignored. I don't know what else could be done other than have the police present between 8:30 and 8:55 AM during few days, or coming sporadically. Maybe the city traffic specialists could have a look at the situation and suggest more signs or different kind of traffic regulations for the street (i.e. do not stop anywhere during 8:30-9 AM)

Even though this might be perceived as a traffic issue, at the end, it is a safety issue. I do hope there is something you could do to force this careless and selfish parents to obey the law and contribute to the order and safety of our community. I don't know how else to support the school authorities on this frustrating experience, so I decided to inform you to see what else could be done.

Dear Angie,

My name is Joanne Igercich and I am the Principal of St. Margaret of Scotland Catholic School. I would like to bring to your attention the grid lock and safety issue that is experienced on Council Ring Road and in our school driveway on a daily basis.

In order to assist you in understanding our concerns I have attached a graphic plan which illustrates our observations during the student dismissal period at the end of the school day.

Each morning and particularly each afternoon, traffic is at a standstill as vehicles are attempting to turn into the driveway. Some vehicles are trying to turn left into the driveway while others are turning right. The same occurs as vehicles are exiting the driveway, some attempting to turn left, some going straight and others turning right. To compound the problem, vehicles are parked illegally on Council Ring Road directly in front of the school. This allows for only one lane of traffic to flow through. Vehicles that are legally parked further west along Council Ring Road are also contributing to the problem because once again, only one lane of traffic can make its way down the street.

This daily occurrence is causing a great deal of frustration for drivers, school staff and our neighbours but more importantly it is a safety issue. Parents who have parked illegally are not using the crosswalk. They are walking through traffic to get their children into their vehicles. The other safety concern is that if there were to be an emergency at the school or anywhere along Council Ring Road, emergency vehicles could not make their way through because of this gridlock.

Unfortunately the volume of traffic is not going to diminish but only increase over the upcoming years. Here is some additional information which supports this prediction.

St. Margaret of Scotland has a population of 542 students. Two hundred and forty-two
of these students attend our French Immersion program. French Immersion students
are not eligible for transportation so as a result many of these students are transported
to and from school each day by their parents/guardians. Beginning in September 2014,
we will have 46 more students attending our French Immersion program which
translates into potentially 46 more vehicles on Council Ring Road and entering our
driveway in the morning and evening.

 To add to the congestion, in September 2014, Brookmede Public School (which is now undergoing renovation) is scheduled to open. The school is right next door to St.
 Margaret of Scotland. This opening will add additional traffic to Council Ring Road and once again compound the existing gridlock and safety problem.

I am hoping that you can assist us in responding to our safety concerns as well as helping to alleviate this constant and increasing problem.

I would like to suggest some ways in which this problem might be addressed, which are also illustrated in the graphic provided:


- 1. Place "No Left Turn" signs on Council Ring Road in front of the school. The "No Left Turn" could be in place for designated times. For example, between 8:15 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and between 2:45 and 3:30 p.m.
- 2. Place "No Left Turn" signs at the school driveway exit, again stipulating the above times.
- 3. Ticket (on a regular basis) those vehicles that are illegally parked in front of the school.
- 4. Change the parking signs on Council Ring Road west of the school to indicate "No Parking" between 2:30 to 3:30 p.m.

I do hope that this letter has highlighted our cause for concern and that you will be able to assist us. Should you have any further questions or require further information, please do not hesitate to contact me. I look forward to connecting with you at your earliest convenience.
