Sheelagh Duffin, Crossing Guard Supervisor provided a verbal update on the site inspection that was conducted on January 22, 2014 and the feedback she had received from the crossing guard in the area. Ms. Duffin advised that there is a lot of congestion at the end of the day. The students who attend this school are not from the area and are not being bused in but rather having parents drive them to school. It was discussed that although there have been recommendations made in the past, there needs to be more direction from the school boards and it was recommended that the Traffic Safety Council write a

letter to the School Boards to encourage the principals to communicate to parents the rules and practices of the school zones. Dan Suess suggested that the School Board review the bus policy for French Immersion schools. Councillor Frank Dale requested that Transportation and Works review the No Stopping on Council Ring Road and to have the Emergency Medical Services write a letter to the School Board about the situation. Ms. Duffin advised that there are already "No Stopping" signs in place. Peter Westbrook suggested that the other schools in the area offset their start and dismissal times. I am in receipt of the above noted recommendation from Traffic Safety Council (TSC) regarding transit stop locations on Bristol Road across from St. Francis Xavier Secondary School and at the intersection of Hurontario Street and Bristol Road and provide the following comments.

TSC-0123-2013 from Traffic Safety Council stated:

That MiWay be requested to review the feasibility of relocating the westbound bus stop on Bristol Road in front of St. Francis Xavier Secondary School closer to the intersection of Hurontario Street and Bristol Road to provide safe crossing at the signalized intersection and further that MiWay review relocating the northbound bus stop on the east side of Hurontario Street closer to Bristol Road so students can cross the intersection at the traffic signals.

MiWay Service Development staff completed an infield review on Wednesday January 29th, 2014 to consider the concerns raised by Traffic Safety Council at both stop #3406-Bristol Road West at Hurontario Street and at the intersection of Bristol Road and Hurontario Street (stop #1950).

Stop #3406 – Bristol Road West at Hurontario Street:

MiWay does not recommend relocating Stop #3406 from its current location for the following reasons:

The stop is currently served by **Route 10-Bristol-Britannia** when it is travelling north from the City Centre Transit Terminal (see: Transit Stops – Bristol & Hurontario). Based on 2012 ridership data, there are 158 passenger boarding and 11 passengers alighting from Route 10 at this location. Dismissal time at St. Francis Xavier is at 2:20 pm. Between dismissal and 2:36 pm, there are 69 passengers boarding at stop #3406 which represents 44% of the total daily passenger boardings at this stop.

Although it is feasible to shift this stop approximately 43 metres easterly (closer to Hurontario Street) it would place the stop roughly 45 metres west of the signalized intersection of

Q 9

Hurontario Street and Bristol Road. Due to our Route 10 service turning left from Hurontario Street onto Bristol Road, we are unable to physically complete the northbound left turn and manoeuvre the bus into the curb lane within this distance.

MiWay strives to locate stops at or near controlled intersections (all-way stops and traffic signals) however this is not always possible given the location of passenger generators/attractions (ie: St. Francis Xavier Secondary School) and in this case, our Route 10 operators completing a northbound left turn before servicing the stop located on Bristol Road. Shifting stop #3406 to the east would reduce the walking distance for MiWay customers transferring from Hurontario (Routes 19, 19A, 19B & 103) to westbound Route 10 however this move may have a negative effect on passenger safety.

Given the tendencies of high school students, should the stop be shifted easterly, it is likely the students will end up walking on a diagonal from the front of the school to the relocated transit stop rather than cross at the signal at Hurontario Street and Bristol Road and walking back to the stop. Moving the stop would both increase the walking distance as well as the student's exposure to vehicular traffic. By maintaining the stop in its current location (although it involves students crossing Bristol Road in front of the school), the majority of the passengers are meeting the 2:33 pm and 2:36 pm northbound Route 10 trips (carrying 28 and 41 passengers respectively) and this is occurring outside of the peak roadway operating hours.

Stop #1950 - Hurontario Street at Bristol Road:

In regards to locating the northbound stop on the east side of Hurontario Street closer to Bristol Road (stop #1950), the location of the stop was reviewed on January 29, 2014. The field review confirmed that the stop and shelter are located as close as possible to Bristol Road (see attached drawing: Bristol & Hurontario-Looking North) and as such, it is not possible to move the existing stop any closer to Bristol Road.







Dear Angie,

My name is Joanne Igercich and I am the Principal of St. Margaret of Scotland Catholic School. I would like to bring to your attention the grid lock and safety issue that is experienced on Council Ring Road and in our school driveway on a daily basis.

In order to assist you in understanding our concerns I have attached a graphic plan which illustrates our observations during the student dismissal period at the end of the school day.

Each morning and particularly each afternoon, traffic is at a standstill as vehicles are attempting to turn into the driveway. Some vehicles are trying to turn left into the driveway while others are turning right. The same occurs as vehicles are exiting the driveway, some attempting to turn left, some going straight and others turning right. To compound the problem, vehicles are parked illegally on Council Ring Road directly in front of the school. This allows for only one lane of traffic to flow through. Vehicles that are legally parked further west along Council Ring Road are also contributing to the problem because once again, only one lane of traffic can make its way down the street.

This daily occurrence is causing a great deal of frustration for drivers, school staff and our neighbours but more importantly it is a safety issue. Parents who have parked illegally are not using the crosswalk. They are walking through traffic to get their children into their vehicles. The other safety concern is that if there were to be an emergency at the school or anywhere along Council Ring Road, emergency vehicles could not make their way through because of this gridlock.

Unfortunately the volume of traffic is not going to diminish but only increase over the upcoming years. Here is some additional information which supports this prediction.

St. Margaret of Scotland has a population of 542 students. Two hundred and forty-two
of these students attend our French Immersion program. French Immersion students
are not eligible for transportation so as a result many of these students are transported
to and from school each day by their parents/guardians. Beginning in September 2014,
we will have 46 more students attending our French Immersion program which
translates into potentially 46 more vehicles on Council Ring Road and entering our
driveway in the morning and evening.

 To add to the congestion, in September 2014, Brookmede Public School (which is now undergoing renovation) is scheduled to open. The school is right next door to St.
 Margaret of Scotland. This opening will add additional traffic to Council Ring Road and once again compound the existing gridlock and safety problem.

I am hoping that you can assist us in responding to our safety concerns as well as helping to alleviate this constant and increasing problem.

I would like to suggest some ways in which this problem might be addressed, which are also illustrated in the graphic provided:


- 1. Place "No Left Turn" signs on Council Ring Road in front of the school. The "No Left Turn" could be in place for designated times. For example, between 8:15 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and between 2:45 and 3:30 p.m.
- 2. Place "No Left Turn" signs at the school driveway exit, again stipulating the above times.
- 3. Ticket (on a regular basis) those vehicles that are illegally parked in front of the school.
- 4. Change the parking signs on Council Ring Road west of the school to indicate "No Parking" between 2:30 to 3:30 p.m.

I do hope that this letter has highlighted our cause for concern and that you will be able to assist us. Should you have any further questions or require further information, please do not hesitate to contact me. I look forward to connecting with you at your earliest convenience.

Thank you for your enquiry concerning a Mississauga Traffic Safety Council warrant study for the implementation of a crossing guard at the intersection of Rathburn Road and Willowbank Trail.

For your information, there had been a crossing guard in place at the intersection of Rathburn Road and Willowbank Trail for many years up to last year. However, Traffic Safety Council conducted site inspections at this intersection in the spring and fall of 2012 and determined that the warrants were no longer met and therefore the crossing guard was removed at the Christmas Break, December 21, 2012.

At a signalized intersection, it is the number of turning vehicles when pedestrians could be in the crosswalk crossing Rathburn Road as well as the number of crossing pedestrians that determines if there is a warrant for a crossing guard. The traffic on Rathburn Road is controlled by the traffic control signals.

Hi Lisa:

- An EA, required for the road extension, should flush out all of the environmental issues as well as a mitigation plan.
- The EA, design and construction of the Sheridan Park Drive extension can be considered during 2015 budget discussions. It is probable that the EA could be included in the 2015 Budget, however, not sure how it will fit into our 2015 workplan. I hope we could at least scope it out in 2015. I am not sure of any property needs, but this would be confirmed during the EA.
- The construction of a sidewalk will be a significant challenge as indicated in the previous communication. As
 well, there is also the consideration of cycling along N. Sheridan Way. Perhaps this spring when the snow is
 gone, we can arrange a walkabout with appropriate staff and reps from SPA. Consideration of a shared venture
 needs to be investigated because of the challenges.

Gentlemen,

In conversations with Tim Smith (our consultant at Urban Strategies) we were discussing the conflict between the Regional Core Greenlands, a possible City SWM facility/CVC protected area and the extension of Sheridan Park Drive. Can you shed some light for me on how we can work together accommodate a road (very much desired by the Sheridan Park Association due to significant traffic at peak hours) and still maintain environmental integrity in the vicinity of such sensitive lands? Would the EA help flush out how we can make both work?

Also to Steve, can we put the extension of Sheridan Park Drive back in the capital budget loop? And, the SPA is still very very interested in a sidewalk on North Sheridan Way. It was noted to us that there is quite a lot of pedestrian movement along that road, and given the poor sightlines, and now snowbanks, it is very unsafe. We were at a meeting in the park on Tuesday afternoon, and a number of people walked to the Suncor building rather than drive. We need to somehow accommodate pedestrians, cause clearly they are there!!

Finally to Steve, the private school is creating traffic chaos at its peak times...what else is new with a school? Can/would we put lane lines on Speakman Drive so that traffic can queue in a left turn lane for westbound, and a right turn lane for eastbound traffic, while still allowing through traffic to proceed? I haven't seen it myself, but it is a common complaint.

I spoke to the Principal, Ms. Patterson, of Whitehorn Public School on Friday, February 14, 2014. Ms. Patterson expressed concern about the behaviour of parents at the kiss & ride. There are several parents who ignore the rules of the kiss & ride and are placing students and staff in danger by their carelessness. These behaviours have been increasing and are becoming very serious. She advised that when the parents have been spoken to about their behaviour, the parent is extremely rude back to staff and volunteers and continue to be careless at the kiss & ride. There are also several issues when it comes to the traffic congestion in front of the school, with cars parking illegally, and making improper turns and blocking traffic.

Ms. Patterson advised me that there was a letter that was sent home to the parents to advise that the Kiss & Ride will not be operating effective February 18, 2014 until further notice. Ms. Patterson also advised that she has been in touch with the Peel Regional Police to have them patrol the area for those who are violating the HTA. She also advised that she had just been on the telephone with Parking Enforcement and that there would be Parking Enforcement Officers on-site for Tuesday, February 18, 2014, and, that staff from Parking Enforcement will be attending Whitehorn Public School on Thursday, February 20th in the evening to address this issue at a parent assembly. Ms. Patterson did not indicate when she would resume the Kiss & Ride Program.

I have put a request for the Traffic Safety Council to conduct a site inspection at this location and that there would be the need to conduct another site inspection once I am advised that the Kiss & Ride program is operating again. This matter will be on the next TSC agenda as a site inspection request.

I will advise you of any comments/recommendations of the site inspection once I receive them.

Dear school administration staff, school superintendent of education, school trustee,

We the undersigned; parents and guardians of Whitehorn Public School students; are very disturbed by your sudden decision to close the Kiss'N'Ride routes at Whitehorn Public School as of Feb 18, 2014 and until further notice.

We understand that this has come to ensure the safety of our children and the school staff members after a recent incident that involved safety risk. Although, in taking this decision we believe that you have rushed to taking extreme measures to address this matter instead of attempting to deal with it as an individual incident and solve it with the parties involved.

We all unarguably agree that the safety of our children is our community's top priority, however, closing the Kiss'N'Ride routes will only remove this risk from the school property where the students and parents are guarded by school patrol staff to the streets where there isn't any form of supervision available. As such, there will be more risks resulting from more crossings and traffic especially after diverting the extra traffic from the school's Kiss'N'Ride routes to the nearby streets.

In taking this decision we would expect that you take into account the community safety as a whole instead of focusing on what happens within the school boarders. In the same sense, we believe that we (parents are guardians) should have been involved and consulted with before taking such step that impacted all of us. Unfortunately, no attempt was made to discuss this issue with us or even bringing it to our attention before enforcing these unexpected procedures.

For many of us the Kiss'N'Ride routes is not a luxury that we enjoy, it is a necessity to ensure that our children are dropped off and picked up safe and on time every day. It particularly allows people with babies and young children and people with disabilities and certain health conditions to avoid the risks arising from extreme weather and heavy traffic hazards that may result from accompanying their children to school.

We strongly support the school in its efforts to ensure our children's safety — as well as the staff and parents's safety within the community as a whole. We look forward to meeting with you all sooner than later to further discuss this issue and collectively reach a decision that is both practical and impartial. Meanwhile, we ask that the Kiss'N'Ride routes reopen until a better approach is applied to deal with this issue.
