My name is Margaret Fleese and I live at My two children attend St. Jerome School Elementary School (790 Paisley Blvd. W) I am asking for your assistance because I am extremely concerned about the intersection of Paisley Blvd W and Pollard Drive.

A number of children, including my own two children, cross Paisley every day to attend school. Currently there is no crossing guard, no cross walk, and no signs to alert drivers that young children are crossing this busy street daily to get to school. There are students from the local high school and people wanting to get to Huron Park that speed down Paisley without regard for any of the children crossing. To compound the problem, the City of Mississauga have added two additional bus routes that go into Huron Park. There has been a significant increase in traffic and the crossing situation is getting very dangerous for our children. I have had personally two situations where one of my children was almost hit by a speeding car.

I would desperately ask if someone from your office could come out and assess this situation in our neighbourhood to see if this intersection is eligible for a crossing guard or some sort of traffic signage.


