Mr. Sawhney, resident outlined in a PowerPoint presentation the safety concerns that parents of students attending Meadowvale Village Public School have with respect to condition of sidewalks and curbs, and the traffic congestion along the routes where children will be walking as of September 2015, as a result of Student Transportation of Peel Region's (STOPR) decision to remove bus service to students attending Meadowvale Village Public School.

Tom Howe, Manager, Student Transportation of Peel Region (STOPR), spoke to the process of determining eligibility for students to be bussed.

Parents of students attending Meadowvale Village Public School and St. Julia Catholic School expressed again their concern for the current conditions of the roads the children would be walking along, the traffic congestion in front of the school as children are being dropped off at the Kiss & Ride, speeding vehicles, and the upcoming construction of the Second Line Bridge,

Carlson George Carlson advised that he would be tabling a motion at the next Council meeting on July 8, 2015 with respect to adding a crossing guard at Second Line West and Sombrero Way effective September 2015, and that Traffic Safety Council conduct site inspections in September and October 2015, to determine if the warrants are met to retain a crossing guard at this location.

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

Dear Mr. Khan,

In response to your query regarding the traffic warrants that Traffic Safety Council provides its recommendations on, we provide the following information.

Traffic Safety Council conducts site inspections and gap studies at all locations as per requests received in order to determine if the warrants are met for the implementation of a crossing guard for kindergarten to grade 5 students as well as conducting safety reviews at identified locations for students of any age.

Attached please find a copy of the site inspection report that was completed June 18, 2015 at the intersection of Darcel Avenue and Brandon Gate Drive at times consistent with the school entry and dismissal times of both Corliss Public and Holy Cross Catholic school. The Site Inspection Report contains information concerning the location, weather conditions at the time of the study, information concerning the schools, comments relating to observations regarding behaviour of both traffic and students while students are crossing as well as comments regarding enhancements at the intersection such as the presence of zebra makings and appropriate signage.

The second page is the crossing Guard Warrant Survey. At a signalized intersection the traffic control signals provide stop control for straight through traffic that allows pedestrians to cross on the green signal. Therefore the traffic recorded is the traffic that could impact crossing pedestrians, the number of vehicles turning through the intersection both right and left while pedestrians are or could be in the crosswalk on their green light. The tics recorded in the Gaps area indicate how many vehicles made right or left turns crossing the pedestrian crosswalk by 5 minute intervals. In each 5 minute interval there were 3 or 4 phases of the traffic control signals so the commas separate how many vehicles turned at each phase of the signal.

Also recorded are the number of students crossing as well as any conflicts observed when either vehicles or pedestrians did not yield right of way. Recommendations are based on the information recorded and on the observations made on the Site Inspection Report. In this instance there were few students crossing (a minimum of 5 is required before a warrant can be considered for a crossing guard), no conflicts were observed and, the intersection was well marked. Traffic was observed to be courteous of crossing pedestrians, and, especially considering the length of the traffic light, turning traffic was not heavy. Overall the intersection functioned well and allowed ample time for students to cross. Therefore the warrants were not met for the implementation of a crossing guard.

I can advise you that a site inspection was conducted on June 18, 2015 at the intersection of Darcel Avenue and Brandon Gate Drive for the students attending Corliss Public School and Holy Cross Catholic School. The Traffic Safety Council considered the following recommendation at their meeting on June 24, 2015:



The fatality at Artesian Drive was in 2013 so TSC did conduct a site inspection at Artesian Drive and Southampton directly after the fatality. The warrants were not met for a crossing guard at that time. However, we will definitely schedule a site inspection at that location for September especially in light of the fact that you have made improvements to the intersection.

TSC has also completed several site inspections at both Westbridge Way locations over the years but the most recent would have been about 5 or 6 years ago. We did the same, both at the path off Westbridge Way where a number of students and parents cross, as well as at Belishire Gate. We will schedule both of those for the same date and in the September calendar.

Hi Sheelagh,

I spoke to Heather about these items on Monday I believe.

The Artesian location is at the request of Peel Regional Police. This location, as I'm sure you're aware, is the site of the fatal pedestrian collision last year. As a result of that incident, police have been monitoring this location regularly. Based on their observations, we are making a number of safety enhancements to the intersection including pavement markings and enlarging signs. A crossing guard review is part of the potential safety enhancements.

The Westbridge Way locations are at the request of a local resident through the Councillor's office. There is concern on the part of some parents who have to cross or have their children cross Westbridge Way to go to Levi Creek PS. Many, I was told, cross mid-block at the trail crossing which is why the second location was added here. Again, this is in conjunction with further safety reviews along Westbridge Way.

The results of these reviews can be forwarded to myself and I will gladly include the results in my updates to each requestor.

In the future, I'll forward these requests to you directly. Any questions, let me know.

I am writing to you about a request that I submitted for an additional crosswalk on Clarkson in January when Pat Mullin was still the city councillor. One of my children attends St. Christopher School located off of Clarkson Rd behind St. Christopher Church. In order to go to school by foot or by bike, he must exit our neighbourhood from Birchwood and wait for a gap in the traffic to cross Clarkson Rd to reach the sidewalk on the west side of Clarkson Rd. The east side of Clarkson Rd doesn't have a sidewalk and every resident in this



neighbourhood must wait for a gap in the traffic to cross the street. If there was a sidewalk on the East side of Clarkson Rd then this email would not be necessary. Not only for the safety of my 11 year old son but for all residents in this pocket, we should install a crosswalk at Clarkson Rd and Birchwood. There is already one just north of this intersection (Clarkson and Mazo Cres) and one south in front of St. Christopher school. It might seem redundant however for our safety I believe it's a necessity.


Hello Maria,

Please know that the Brampton criteria for crossing guard placement is the same as that of Mississauga, kindergarten to grade 5 students. There are several scenarios where grades 6, 7. 8 students as well as high school students may also cross with a crossing guard. In the case of the Dufferin Peel Catholic District School Board schools, their elementary schools include kindergarten to grade 8 students. However, the warrant criteria applied for implementation of a crossing guard is still for kindergarten to grade 5 students. In some cases the school entry and dismissal times of a middle school or high school may correspond to the neighbourhood elementary school times. Crossing guards are instructed to cross all persons while they are on duty. This is as per the Highway Traffic Act Section 176. Therefore the crossing guards would cross students regardless of age including adults.

By copy of this email to Heather McGuire I am requesting that the morning site inspection time be extended to 8:00 to 9:00 am to cover the school entry and dismissal times of both Castlebridge Public School and Thomas Street Middle School. The 8:00 to 8:30am time is for a safety review of the intersection while Thomas Street Middle School students are crossing. Traffic Safety Council does make recommendations to Council not only for crossing guard implementation and removal but also for changes to physical signage and signal timings and configurations where necessary to enhance the safety of all students.

Thank-you for your quick response. While I understand that in Mississauga the recommendation for crossing guards only applies to students from kindergarten to grade 5, it is my understanding that in Brampton the criteria does extend to grade 8. Given the frequency of traffic incidents in this particular intersection I would request that the

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needs of students at Thomas Street Middle School also be taken into consideration in the assessment. Since Catholic elementary schools in Mississauga are for the most part K-8, their grade 6-8 students also benefit from the crossing guards in place for the younger students. Castlebridge P.S. only goes to grade 5, thus excluding the grade 6-8 public school students in the area from benefitting from this service. The fact that the students at Thomas Street Middle School begin school 30 minutes earlier and finish school an hour earlier than Castlebridge P.S. students, means that they are not crossing the intersection at the times you have indicated for the inspection. I would also point out that some students beginning in grade 6 may still be 10 years old, and are certainly 11.

In Mississauga, it is the responsibility of the Traffic Safety Council to make recommendations to Council regarding the placement or removal of crossing guards for kindergarten to grade 5 students. Studies show that by the age of 10 or 11, students are capable of making good decisions around crossing the road.

By copy of this email to Heather McGuire I am requesting that she schedule a site inspection for the students of Castlebridge PS at the intersection of Glen Erin Drive and Thomas Street. The south school boundary for Our Lady of Mercy is Thomas Street so there should not be any students crossing Thomas Street for our Lady of Mercy CS. The times of the inspection would be 8:30-9:00 and 3:30-4:00.

A crossing guard was implemented at the intersection of Glen Erin Drive and Thomas Street in September 2014 to accommodate students of Castlebridge Public School in advance of a boundary change for Castlebridge PS that would require that students living south of Thomas Street cross Thomas Street at Glen Erin Drive. The warrants for the crossing were reviewed twice in September and October to determine if the students of Castlebridge PS were crossing at the intersection. The warrant of 5 students using the crossing was not met. Therefore the crossing guard was removed at the Christmas break 2014 as there were no students crossing from the elementary school.

You will be notified of the date of the inspection once it is scheduled should you wish to attend. Thank you for bringing your concern to our attention.




