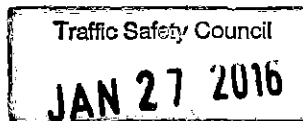

2016 Walk to School Events

Members of the Walk to School Subcommittee discussed the following:

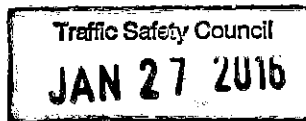
1. Meadowvale Village Public School was approached for a potential launch of the Walk to School Program and, have since agreed to launch the program in early April. Meadowvale Public School will also be participating in the Winter Walk day on February 3, 2016.
2. Consideration will also be given to doing a re-launch at St. Julia Catholic School, at the same time of the launch at Meadowvale Village Public School.
3. A meeting has been scheduled at Shelter Bay Public School on January 27, 2016 to discuss potential launch of the Walk to School Program. Louise Goegan, Chair, Walk to School Subcommittee will update Members at the Traffic Safety Council meeting in January 2016.
4. The Walk to School Subcommittee will also approach Janet I. McDougald Public School to discuss potential launch of the Walk to School Program for the spring.
5. St. Gertrude Catholic School has agreed to pilot a cycling educational program with a relaunch in the Spring. Members would like to see a collaboration with Members of the Mississauga Cycling Advisory Committee to participate in the Walk to School Program relaunch/ Cycling Education Program in the Spring. Peter Westbrook, Chair, Traffic Safety Council, will approach the Chair of the Mississauga Cycling Advisory Committee regarding this initiative.
6. Ray Underhill Public School has raised concerns that there are no sidewalks and children are walking on the roads. Direction was given to have them contact their Ward Councillor to seek assistance with their concerns.
7. Members discussed ways of knowing what schools that have a Walk to School Program in place are still active and what have been their successes and what needs improvement, as well as knowing which schools ceased to continue their Walk to School Program, so that Walk to School Subcommittee Members can work with the school in hopes of relaunching the program. Dan Suess, Citizen Member, volunteered to create a report that can be used to follow up with schools.
8. A meeting was held with PSARTS to discuss ways of working together and collaborating to provide better services to schools without duplicating efforts.
