

Thank you for your enquiry concerning the position of the Mississauga Traffic Safety Council concerning the Camilla Park route that requires students to use the bridge crossing Cooksville Creek to access Munden Park PS.


For clarification, Traffic Safety did not declare the route unsafe. As part of the walk about to assess the suitability of the routes students indicated on the School Walking Routes program surveys that they used to walk to school, the School walking Routes subcommittee did walk the Camilla Park route. However, it was decided that the route would not be signed as a suggested walking route as there was no fencing at the bridge across Cooksville Creek, thereby allowing easy access to the Creek. We subsequently were informed by the Parks Department that the creek did in fact flood and that there was some rehabilitation work that would be undertaken sometime in 2016. As always, it is a parents right to select the route their student uses to walk to school. Therefore, some students do, in fact, use that route to walk to school.

By copy of this email to Heather McGuire, I am requesting that she schedule a site inspection for Camilla Park at the bridge to determine if Traffic Safety does have issues with the Creek in its current state. The site inspection is to include STOPR. The time of the inspection would be 8:00 am to 8:30 am.

You will be notified of the time of the inspection once it is scheduled should you wish to attend

I received a call from Erla Jackett, Vice Principal, at Munden Park Public School following up on a Walk To School route inspection conducted last year, specifically, the Camila Park route.

Ms. Jackett stated that at that time, Peter Westbrook and another female representative of Traffic Safety, advised that the Camila Park route was unsafe and that it would not be recommended as a walking route. Ms. Jackett further stated that she has been in touch with Parks staff from the City of Mississauga and she was advised by them that the Park was in need of much repair.

Ms. Jackett has received several inquiries from parents with respect to the further distance their children need to walk to the school because the Camila Park route is "deemed unsafe", and as such, if TSC deems it unsafe, she will advocate) to get these students school busing.

How refreshing to see someone follow up! Truly appreciate your ongoing support.

I responded to Sheelagh and copied everyone on November 1st and haven't received any acknowledgement since then crickets. See my email below.

I'd like the Traffic Safety Council to explain how any pedestrian crossing Clarkson from our neighbourhood is safe. Waiting for a gap in traffic may work for some but that is not a solution for kids at any part of the day - not just school hours. Who else can I speak to?

Sheelagh,

Thank-you for your response.

I feel like there is a bit of a misunderstanding. My enquiry is not just about getting a crossing guard. It's also about getting a cross walk so that ALL pedestrians have a safe way to cross Clarkson Rd to access the sidewalk on the west side. As for the site inspection, I could have told you in advance that it would have failed due to the fact that parents have made other arrangements over the years for their children to get to school like driving them, car pooling or fill up the bus, which is exactly what we have done. As I'm sure you are aware, we pay robust property taxes in this neighbourhood and yet we do not feel safe crossing Clarkson Rd in order to access the sidewalk. How would the Traffic Safety Council recommend children access the sidewalk even outside of school hours? Wait for a gap in traffic and take a chance?





As for the site inspection, I could have told you in advance that it would have failed due to the fact that parents have made other arrangements over the years for their children to get to school like driving them, car pooling or fill up the bus, which is exactly what we have done. As I'm sure you are aware, we pay robust property taxes in this neighbourhood and yet we do not feel safe crossing Clarkson Rd in order to access the sidewalk. How would the Traffic Safety Council recommend children access the sidewalk even outside of school hours? Wait for a gap in traffic and take a chance?

Would you kindly schedule a site Inspection at the east leg of Duke of York Boulevard and Webb Drive for the students of Fairview Public School in order to determine if the warrants are met for the implementation of a school crossing guard at that location. The times of the inspection would be 8:25 – 8:55 am and 3:20 – 3:50 pm. Student Transportation advises that there are potentially 12 students living east of Duke of York Boulevard that could cross at the east leg of Duke of York Boulevard and Webb Drive.

School boundaries changed with the opening of Chris Hadfield Public School. The new boundary for Fairview Public School is east of Duke of York Boulevard and south of Webb Drive. Therefore students living north of Webb Drive and west of Duke of York Boulevard are no longer walking to Fairview Public School but are instead bused to Chris Hadfield Public.
