Jeff Wachman, Irwin Nayer, Donnie Morris, Don Stephens, Dorothy Tomiuk and Joanne de Cloe of the Mississauga Cycling Advisory Committee (MCAC) spoke to the evolution of cycling in the City of Mississauga, creating partnerships, cycling infrastructure, achieving gold status for the Bicycle Friendly Communities Award, Ontario Summer Games, Pan Am/Parapan Am games, increasing ridership for the 2014 Tour de Mississauga, Ward Rides and cycling educational campaigns.
