Under the direction of the Site Leader or Program Supervisor the successful candidate will assist in the operation and delivery of an outdoor playground program experience as developed by Recreation to meet the needs of participants and to ensure adequate safety while facilitating leisure activities.

- To support objectives and philosophies of the Let's Play in the Park Program through quality instruction and staff and customer relations.
- Plan and implement a comprehensive safe playground program to meet the needs of all participants
- To provide instruction to participants and ensure planning and preparation for all activities related to the playground program are carried out successfully.
- To ensure supervision of participants at all times and provide a safe and enjoyable experience for all participants by adhering to department safety standards and assisting with emergency procedures as required.
- To provide quality customer service and act as a knowledgeable resource to parents, participants, volunteers and other staff.
- To effectively and in a timely manner inform the Program Supervisor / Designate with regards to all aspects related to parks or location, staffing, participant behavior, equipment, supplies or anything that would impact the quality and safe delivery of day to day operations of the program.
- To conduct safety checks of program equipment and park areas daily. Clean up and store equipment appropriately at the end of the day.
- Incorporate and model the HIGH FIVE® Principles of Healthy Child Development in program delivery where appropriate.

Here is what you need:

- Willing to work at outdoor park environment for the duration of the contract, transportation between locations is required
- Must hold a valid Emergency First Aid/CPR "B" certificate Certification (Lifesaving Society, Canadian Red Cross Society, St. John's Ambulance or the Canadian Ski Patrol).
- Previous experience working with children is an asset.
- Employment offer is conditional upon receipt of a Criminal Records Search - Vulnerable Sector Screening that is acceptable to the City of Mississauga.
- HIGH FIVE® Principles of Healthy Child Development.

What we pay

Duties and responsibilities of the Outdoor Leader, Play in the Park (Leader III, Camps) will be paid: \$14.35 - \$14.75 per hour.

During mandatory training and staff meetings staff will be paid \$14.00 per hour.
