Postal service will get better - Abbott

Postal service here "leaves a lot to be desired" but Mississauga MP Tony Abbott feels things are going to get better.

Speaking last week to the Mississauga City Board of Trade, Abbott said he hesitated "to use the word catastrophic" in describing the postal situation in the past, but his government is on the threshold of better things.

He noted the Gateway Postal Facility in Mississauga "has been extremely difficult to break in but we feel it is just starting to function."

Abbott defended legislation taking the right to strike away from postal workers during an election period, and not "just because it means our election literature won't be distributed.

"With the government dissolved during an election, there's no one really to call them back to their jobs."

Abbott said residents should "be patient" as the postal delivery problem in Mississauga will be solved soon.
