Viola Amos, 71, of 23 Brant St. died of cancer in Mississauga General Hospital last Wednesday.

Miss Amos was involved in the newspaper business all her life.

She began with the Port Credit Weekly, owned by Charters Publishing Co., where she handled a gift shop on the premises. She also looked after classified advertising, news and social events.

When Charters bought out The Advertiser from Edwin Eland, Miss Amos followed and remained as circulation manager until retirement in the early 1970s.

However, later she returned to work, first at the Weston Times and then at the Mississauga Times.

She liked children and taught Sunday school in Trinity Anglican Church in Port Credit. She also became involved in the nursery department where her energies never diminished.
