Malton volunteer worker dies

A popular Malton resident, noted for his volunteerism in the community, died of a heart attack on Monday.

Piara Singh Bains, 67, formerly of Almadale Court, had been ill for a while, said his friend Raghbir Singh Sandhu. His funeral was held today (Wednesday).

"He was considered very highly and was a loyal and distinguished member of our community and as a

volunteer in our area," Sandhu said.

He was awarded the Centennial Award in 1984 for significant contributions to the community during his retirement years and was a director of the Senior Asian Association of Malton. He was also a director of the newly formed Can Sikh Cultural Association and "we remember him as a good friend and sympathetic person," Sandhu added.
