



Centennial Aerobatic Pilot

Flight Lieutenant ^{WEEKLY AUG 2 1966} D. J. Barker, Lakeview, has been appointed as lead solo pilot, to The Golden Centennaires. Flight Lieutenant Barker joined the RCAF in 1954 and has been stationed in Germany, Portage la Prairie, Manitoba and Trenton, Ontario. He was a member of the extinct Golden Hawks. The Golden Centennaires are a flying aerobatic team, being formed to present airshows primarily to Canadians, commemorating Centennial year. They will be flying the Canadair-built Tutor, a jet trainer.
