

# Cooksville historian Mildred Belleghem dies

Life-long Cooksville resident and well-known local historian Mildred Louise Belleghem (nee Belford) died recently.

She was 89. A lifetime member of St. John the Baptist Anglican Church in Mississauga,

Belleghem published historical works that are contained in the Mississauga Library. Two of her books chronicled the history of her family. The titles are: *As the Mill Stone Still Turns*; and, *From Creagh Kenagh to Port Credit* — A

*Belford Story*. Belleghem taught school for many years in Cooksville and Port Credit.

She was predeceased by her husband of 53 years, Jack Belleghem, and is survived by four daughters and two sons.
