
Bradley stil

Alan Bradley has been re-elected head of the local hydro commission, which he has chaired since August 1977.

At its first meeting of 1990, the five-member Hydro Mississauga commission returned the engineer to his longtime post as chairman. This summer, Bradley will celebrate his 20th year as a member of the commission, to which he is appointed by city council.

The Applewood Acres resident, who works for Dywidag System International, is a former public school trustee who also served as chairman on that body for four years.

Former Ward 7 city councillor Ron Starr was re-elected to his second term as vice-chairman of the commission. The self-employed consultant, who is also an engineer, was recently elected president of the Mississauga Board of Trade. The longtime Sherway resident served on city council for one term



in 1978 and 1979.

The other members of the commission are Ron Walker, former chairman of the Streetsville Public Utilities Commission, Ontario Hydro engineer Richard Ronchka, and Mayor Hazel McCallion.
