An era is ending for the New Democratic Party in Mississauga with the defection of two Streetsville families. Nov. 26 - 86 MN

Reverend David Busby and his wife, Norah, have moved to Barrie, to a new posting at a church there. David Busby was a federal candidate once and a provincial candidate twice and came within 500 votes in 1975 of becoming the city's first-ever NDP representative to provincial or federal Parliament. His wife, Norah, was the longtime public school board trustee for Ward 9.

Robert and Sylvia Weylie are moving to Cheltenham, farther north in Peel. Sylvia ran in the past two elections in Mississauga North and is well known for her community work and her professional work with school librarians and the Ontario Federation of Women Teachers.

Her husband is the former reeve of Streetsville and the former president of the Streetsville Residents' Association.
