Mississauga artist shows watercolors at Civic Centre

Old cars, barns, rural and urban buildings, train stations, old boats — Mississauga artist Gil Caldwell paints them all.

And he'll be showing his colorful watercolors through December at Mississauga's Civic Centre.

Caldwell, a vice-principal in Etobicoke, and a part-time artist and designer, has been a resident of Mississauga since 1963. A graduate of the Ontario College of Art, he has had both one-man and group shows throughout the Toronto area. His work has been seen at the O'Keefe Centre, the Toronto Dominion Centre, Hart House at the University of Toronto and Erindale College. He has also had past shows at the Mississauga Civic Centre.

Caldwell describes his style as strong - reminiscent of the work of Canadian painter A.J. Casson and the late Albert Frank. He says he works from personal photos and pencil sketches, and does the actual paintings in the studio in his house.

In 1975, Caldwell formed his own art group, call-
