Catto received the award for his rapid response to a house fire in which he saved the life of Erma Gorrell on June 15, 1980. Catto risked his life by entering the flaming home on his hands and knees. He managed to drag Gorrell 15 metres to safety where he applied artificial respiration until assistance arrived.
