Cherry signs two-year deal to remain on Coach's Corner

Hockey fans all over the country will be getting two more years of Don Cherry.

The iconic broadcasting personality and long time Mississauga resident has agreed to a multi-year extension with Rogers to remain with Coach's Corner, the intermission segment on Hockey Night in Canada.

Along with Ron McLean, the 82-year-old had co-starred on Coach's Corner for 30 years, but his contract was set to expire at the end of the NHL playoffs.

Cherry, a well-respected coach with the Boston Bruins and Colorado Rockies before entering the broadcasting realm, is well known for his controversial opinions on hockey and politics, and often pays homage to those who serve in the armed forces.

He was also part of the original ownership group of the Mississauga IceDogs and coached the Ontario Hockey League club in the 2001-02 season.
