This week we introduce to our readers another officer of the Association, Mr. Robert Coates. Like some of the other executive members, Bob came to Park Royal from Montreal in August 1960 when he was transferred here by his employer.

Bob is employed as a Station Operator for Trans Northern Pipe Lines, a company that transports liquid petroleum products through hundreds of miles of underground pipe lines.
