

Constance cooks up a storm - two ways

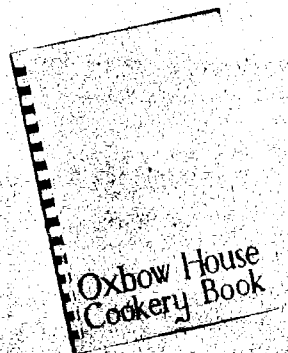

The Oxbow House Cookery Book is Canada's first metric and standard cookbook.

It is a handsome book, handwritten by the artist and crammed with illustrations by Alan Crossley of early inns and homes in Erindale, Cooksville and Streetville.



The book is crammed with local quotes, unusual recipes from early times as well as up-to-the-minute time-savers.

It was launched with a champagne reception on Oct. 21 at the studio.
