Wally Deakon, former Liberal MP for High Park and a resident of Mississauga for many years, died last week at the age of 58.

Deakon represented the Toronto riding for four years until 1972 when he was defeated by Conservative Otto Jelinek.

The lawyer and engineer leaves his wife Olga and sons Tim, of Ottawa, and Tony, of Mississauga. Deakon died suddenly at St. Michael's hospital in Toronto.

After he left Parliament, Deakon was active for many years in local Liberal associations and was at one time vice-president of the Toronto and District Liberal Association.
