Dixon is known for his work in women's fashion and is considered one of Canada's most respected designers.

His modern designs have won him a devoted following and they have been featured in Vogue, Marie Claire, Flare, MTV and Project Runway.

He apprenticed with well-known designer Alfred Sung and, in 1995, established the David Dixon label, which is headquartered in Mississauga.

Dixon is nominated in the Fashion Impact Award category which, according to the CAFA website, is presented to a Canadian designer or brand that has made a significant social or philanthropic impact in

The awards will be presented during a gala that happens April 7 in Toronto.
