Denny Doherty, that is, star performer with the musical group, The Mamas and the Papas.

The group is now appearing at the Imperial Room in the Royal York Hotel and Doherty grabbed a chance during a special opening-night performance Monday to tell the crowd that he and his family are about to become the newest on an ever-increasing list of celebrities to make Mississauga their home.
