

Little Lindsay soon to be released

Lindsay Eberhardt, the 35-month-old Mississauga girl who received a liver transplant in Boston six weeks ago, is expected to leave the hospital on Friday.

The feisty tot is more than a month ahead of her recovery and has for the past week been released for up to eight hours at a time to visit with her mother, Christine, at a nearby apartment.

After a speedy recovery in Boston's Children's Hospital, Lind-

say contracted a virus and hepatitis, and vomitted blood for several days.

Now that she's overcome that setback, doctors expect she just may be able to move back to her Mississauga home in time for her third birthday April 21.

Bob Jung, owner of China Sea Restaurant in Mississauga, raised \$282 for the family last week. He will also donate all the money his Malton restaurant makes today (Wednes-

day) to the Eberhardt family. "She is a very sweet little girl," says Jung. "So friendly. When she was sick, I thought my restaurant could help the family out."

Jung expects to raise a total of \$1,000 if "everyone goes out of their way to order take-out food from his 12-year-old restaurant."
