Jim said he and his wife Christine found out their daughter, who suffered from biliary atresia and underwent a liver transplant in early February, would leave Boston Children's Hospital last week. But they held back the good news pending the outcome of some blood work tests done over the weekend.

Jim also said Lindsay is now standing on her own. He explained she gets around on a four-wheeled scooter bike but one day last week, decided to look out a window. So she pulled herself up on her scooter and peered out.

Lindsay and Christine will come back to Mississauga on a regular U.S. Air flight.
