

Brian Fleming cracks the century club



The director of education for the Dufferin-Peel Roman Catholic Separate School Board has been named one of the top education administrators in North America.

Brian Fleming was recently announced as making the *Executive Educator* 100 list for his work in the separate school board here.

The Executive Educator is a magazine produced by the National School Boards Association out of Alexandria, Virginia, and each year it names 100 people who have been singled out in recognition of their outstanding executive work.

An announcement of the award plus a description of Fleming's accomplishments will be published in the February issues of the Executive Educator and the American School Board Journal, which is sent

to more than 100,000 educators across North America.

According to Sally Zakariya, managing editor of Executive Educator, the criteria for making the list include managing of mandated programs, working effectively within the political aspects of education, and spearheading new initiatives.

To be considered for the award Fleming had to nominated. He is also the only Canadian to make the Executive Educator 100 this year.

Fleming has been with the Dufferin-Peel board since its inception in 1968 and has served as the director for the past eight years.

However, Fleming announced his resignation from the board and will take up a post with the provincial Ministry of Education in July.
