Seven years ago a business career was not in the forefront.

Today, however, Mississauga's June Greene is a respected executive in the Canadian computer field.

This week she became the first female Canadian president for Data Processing Management Association (DPMA), Toronto chapter, a company which specializes in the preparation of data for computers.

In 1970 Greene started her career with Source Data Control, and is now sales manager for Data Business Data Processing. (The data division of Source Data changed hands and became Business Data Processing).
