Roy Ivor ^{MT}
dead at 99

Roy Ivor, who founded the Winding Lane Bird Sanctuary on Mississauga Road in the 1930s, died Monday at a nursing home in Mississauga.

Ivor, who won the Order of Canada in 1974 and was one of the first naturalists to warn of the dangers of DDT, would have been 100 years old on Jan. 3. He had been in poor health for many years.

Ivor was also awarded an honorary doctorate in Science from the University of Windsor.

Funeral services are tomorrow at 1:30 p.m. at the Lee Funeral Home.
