"I just did what I had to do. I didn't want to get a big award," Jones said after receiving a big award recently at the Port Credit Yacht Club.

Jones, a member of the 1st Streetsville Scouts, received the Certificate for Meritorious Conduct award from Scouts Canada. Only about five of these awards are handed out across the country each year.

The incident happened over a year ago at the Jones family cottage.

"We were playing with water guns and he just backed off the end of the dock," said Jones, a Grade 6 student at Ray Underhill elementary school. "I just walked over, put my hands under the water and lifted him up.

After pulling young William Smith out of the water, Jones pushed on the younger boy's stomach to force out the water. Jones cried for help, then carried Smith up to his parents.

The Smith boy said at the award ceremony that he was never scared — he was just cold.


His parents, Peter and Sandy Smith, were plenty scared.

Sandy Smith said the kids are always required to wear a life jacket near the water, but the rule was forgotten that day amidst all the excitement over getting the cottages ready for the summer.
