

# Terry Jones gets Queen's Park post

Mississauga North MPP Terry Jones has been appointed parliamentary secretary to Municipal Affairs and Housing Minister Dennis Timbrell, the man he supported for the leadership of the Ontario Conservative party.

Jones says he is excited by the prospects in the new job, where he will have a special interest in housing issues. He will deal with the Ontario

Housing Corporation, the Ontario Land Corporation, and the province's extensive real estate operation.

The Streetsville resident says he will be working closely with Mississauga's municipal officials and with the city's extensive secondary industries that are related to housing.

Kennedy remains parliamentary secretary to the intergovernmental affairs ministry. However, Kennedy no longer reports to Tom Wells, who has left the Cabinet. The MPP reports to Premier Frank Miller, who is running the intergovernmental affairs portfolio.
