Dancer June 30, 1976 honored

Mississauga resident Karen Kain, the principal dancer with the National Ballet of Canada, has been named to become an Officer of the Order of Canada, the second highest of the three levels of the award.

She was among five Toronto area residents chosen as officers of the order by the five man selection committee headed by Chief Justice Bora Laskin.

Kain was joined by Vincent Bladen, professor emeritus of the University of Toronto; Allen Lambert, president of the Toronto Dominion Bank; Irving Layton, famed Canadian poet and the Very Rev. A. B. B. Moore, a former moderator of the United Church.

The Order of Canada was created by the federal government in 1967 to recognize outstanding achievement and service.
