Ernest Majury, a tireless employee of the Peel Children's Aid Society for 15 years, died Monday morning at Princess Margaret Hospital in Toronto.

Majury died following a two-year illness. He learned he had contacted cancer only a month before he retired in June of 1972.

"He was a leader in child welfare in this province", praised fellow-Children's Aid member Ron Searle Monday night at city council.

"Even during his illness he never failed to advise the board of what he considered the best course of action. We have lost one of the finest public servants this region has ever known", the councillor said.

The Ernest Majury daycare centre was dedicated by Mississauga last year. Majury, who never missed a day of work in his 15 years of employment with the Children's Aid, will be buried in Willowdale on Thursday.

Commented Councillor Searle: "If ever anyone deserved the epitaph 'Suffer the little children to come unto me', it was Ernie Majury".
