## Norman elected Lieutenant-Governor

# Local Kiwanis member wins post

Stanley Norman, a member of the Kiwanis Club of Mississauga South, has been elected Lieutenant-Governor, Division 7, of the Eastern Canada and Caribbean District of Kiwanis International.

Norman has been a member of Kiwanis for 40 years, and joined the Kiwanis Club of Clarkson-Lorne Park (now the Kiwanis Club of Mississauga South) in 1959. He has served twice as president of those clubs.

Division No. 7 covers the area west of Casa Loma to Oakville, and north to Brampton and Georgetown.

Meanwhile, Mississauga South Kiwanis members Dick Costigan and Norman represented the club at a 75th Anniversary Celebration of Kiwanis International held in Detroit Jan. 20 and 21.

During the past year, Kiwanis International's 315,000 members, who are from 74 nations around the world, carried out a total of 127,000 service projects. They raised and spent \$65 million for service activities, and contributed more than 22 million hours of their own time and talents as volunteers.

The Kiwanis Club of Mississauga South was formed by a merger of the Kiwanis Club of Dixie and the Kiwanis Club of Clarkson-Lorne Park. They have been rendering community service to Mississauga since 1954.
